

ALL-SPORTS AWARDS DESCRIPTION

The Long Beach Century Club presents All-Sports Award plaques for Boys' Sports, Girls' Sports and Overall Sports (combined boys', girls' and coed sports). Schools competed in two divisions starting in the 2005-2006 school year. In 2021-2022 the award presentation changed to one awardee out of three divisions.

These awards are based on total points scored throughout the school year. All schools score points based on where they finish in their divisions.

The point system is like the one used in the Moore League at the high school level. Each team receives points based on its finish in each sport. A team receives 7 points for first place, 6 points for second and so on. The All-City Champion receives 2 additional points, and the runner-up gets 1 additional point. A team may earn the maximum 9 points in a sport by placing first in the division and winning the championship.

In summary, the school that runs the most complete athletic program with emphasis on all sports will win the Overall Sports Award.
